RUNOFF: Direct mail flyers from Smith attacking Cougle, spark outrage

But none of those races has drawn the intensity that has erupted in District 9, where incumbent Mike Smith is being challenged by attorney David Cougle. Their runoff election is set for Nov. 18.

That battle went to an even higher-level last week when residents of the district began receiving the latest of sev-

eral direct mail flyers from Smith, which compared the two candidates. Critics of statements from Smith said he insinuated Cougle, a 20-year military veteran, may have been connected to terrorism.

The flyer was not much different than most campaign mailers until Smith mentioned the following in his flyer about Cougle's back-

ground:

--Immigration lawyer working for immigrants trying to get into the

--Lived several years in the Middle East: Iraq, Jordan, etc.

--Speaks fluent Ara-

bic. The information in the flyer is completely factual, but Smith made a point to not mention that Cougle is a 20-year U.S. service veteran who achieved the rank of Commander with the U.S. Naval Reserve. His time in the Middle East was several lengthy deployments, and the military selected him to learn Arabic—an extremely difficult language to learn-so he could be utilized at a higher level than many other servicemen.

Cougle, and dozens of others on social media, as well as publicly in Slidell, erupted with outrage at what they said was a clear attempt by Smith to make Cougle look like a possible terrorist.

Smith's own Facebook page had seven lengthy posts from those who were shocked about the flyer, while Cougle had dozens of others on social media also express their reactions negatively to what Smith had said.

"This my friends is as low as any politician can go," said Wilson Bastidas. "Mike Smith you should be ashamed for questioning a decorated service member enlisted achieved the officer rank he currently holds--Commander! What are you implying here?"

Many others came right out and said Smith was insinuating that Cougle was a terrorist, when he was actually a 20-year military veteran.

"I know David to be a Navy Commander who was deployed to the Middle East in service to our Nation. He is a good man and a Christian, not an Islamic terrorist," said recently

elected Parish Councilman Patrick Burke. "This is a slap in the face to ALL VETERANS who have served and been deployed to the Middle East."

Smith and Gene Bellisario (former Parish Councilman who has supported Smith during the campaign) have reached the low of the low. How is that even relevant in your opponent's background? Why would you insult his service to our country??? Insulting a man's service is a new low and disgusting! It's an insult to ALL MEN AND WOMEN who have served. I hope you are proud of your new low gentlemen!" said City Councilman Brownfield.

"Mike Smith insinuates that David has Middle-Eastern ties, and gives the impression that he could be a terrorist," said Beverly Roser. "If this skunk, Mike Smith, is willing to openly do this, what do you think he'll do to us?"

Cougle was equally shocked by the flyer.

"This implies something nefarious about service time." Cougle said. "I have had many other veterans call me and say they were insulted. For him to do this, well, it's shocking to see him go so low."

Smith was questioned about the reason for the statement in the flyer and had few words.

"Nothing in the flyer is not accurate," he said. When asked why he

left out the facts about Cougle serving for 20 years he said, "I didn't want to say anything about the military since I didn't want it to seem derogatory."

When asked why he needed to publish that information, which has seemingly nothing to do with being a Parish Councilman, Smith declined to say anything

"That's all I'm going to say about it," Smith

Cougle was also upset by the statement about him helping immigrants enter the country, saying it implied he was helping others come here illegally, when he has only taken cases as a lawyer to help immigrants come here legally.

Cougle, who has never run for public office before, only entered the race after becoming one of the first leaders to stand up against the sexually explicit books in the public libraries.

Cougle was among the founders of the St. Tammany Library Accountability Project (STLAP), which has been fighting against the Library Board for over a year to get the challenged books into a restricted area needing parental consent to ac-

Instead, the Library Board, and Director Kelly LaRocca, have steadfastly insisted that all the sexually explicit materials, other than graphic novels (less than 10 books), should be accessible in the library to minors of any

Cougle co-wrote a bill for the Louisiana Legislature earlier this spring that attempted to give the Parish Council more muscle to bring the situation under control, since it is the Parish Council that appoints all but one member of the Library Board.

However, the Parish Council has refused to do anything to step into the fray, with their leadership stating they don't have the authority to order Library Board members what to do. LaRocca was hired by the board, so council members said they do not see any way to control what has become a far left effort here in St. Tammany, and across the country, to sexualize children by allowing them to read pornography, and access highly sexually explicit materi-

Smith came under fire from Cougle for his inactions on the council, along with other Parish Council members, although Smith has defended himself by saying he believes the books should at least be out of the children's or juvenile sections. However, even if the books were put in the adult section, there is no barrier from children walking into those aisles and finding the books. Meanwhile, the majority of books are still accessible in children's and juvenile areas.

Smith stated in his flyer that he only wants to move the books "out of the juvenile section," but has not made a public statement about supporting a restricted section. He added in his flyer that "until state law is changed, the Parish Council has no legal authority to ban books or remove library board members."

Despite that claim from Smith and others, the St. Tammany Library Accountability Project has never advocated to ban books. They have sought a restricted section in the library, just as with R-rated movies, that would require parental approval for minors to access them.

The entire issue of Smith's flyer erupted throughout the area last week, even leading to Cougle being invited to a well-known radio talk show to discuss the mat-

"The entire thing he put in the flyer is disgusting," said Cougle. "It's not only an attack on me, but an attack on anvone who ever served in the Middle East."
